Payment Plan:

Weekly tuition payments will be due the Thursday MORNING prior to the week you plan to attend. Please note the following:

- A onetime Registration Fee of \$30.00 per child is due with registration forms at the time of enrollment.
- Each camper must be signed up for at least 4 weeks of Day Camp.
- Please note that all payment options include daily snacks and lunch.
- Monthly field trips are an additional cost of \$10.00 per child. This cost includes the bus trip, entrance fee, snack and lunch. This payment needs to be made, no later than the day prior to the planned trip.
- Summit Grove Camp accepts cash or check **ONLY** as payment.
- The first week's tuition will be due by **Thursday, June 7, 2012**.
- Tuition is paid according to the payment options above; there are no daily rates or reductions if your child does not attend all of the contracted days.
- Child(ren) will not be allowed to attend camp if payment is not received by the due date.
- Please note there will be a \$25.00 fee for all returned non-sufficient fund checks.

Discount Options:

- A 5% discount is available if tuition is paid for the entire summer up front. Camper must be signed up for a full summer (at least four weeks) to be eligible for discount.

Summit Grove Day Camp 2012 Parent Agreement

I/We hereby enroll our child(ren), _____, in Summit Grove's Summer Day Camp program from June 11, 2012 to August 17, 2012 with the following understanding:

- It is the desire of Summit Grove Camp (SGC) to partner with parents and the community in providing a quality recreational and educational program for children. It is our goal to provide a unique summertime experience that will provide life-long benefits for each child. Counselors are chosen based on their quality of character and desire to be friends and mentors to children. Summit Grove's Day Camp program is designed to help children develop good character and to recognize their importance in the family, community and the world - all in the context of fun and adventure.
- Summit Grove Day Camp is a program of SGC. Camp staff abides by the beliefs and standards of conduct as set forth in the Old & New Testaments of the Holy Bible.
- Proper discipline being necessary for the welfare of each child, as well as for the entire camp, Camp Director(s) and/or other agents of the camp make and enforce camp regulations in a manner consistent with Christian principles (not to include corporal punishment).
- Rules of conduct for campers, which will provide for a safe and life-enriching camp experience, will be clearly communicated to children and parents. SGC reserves the right to dismiss any child who does not cooperate with the program's rules of conduct.
 - Language considered foul or demeaning to others will not be tolerated. SGC reserves the right to dismiss any child whose words or actions repeatedly indicate a disregard for the camp staff or fellow campers, or whose parents' actions are detrimental to the well-being of the camp.
 - Modest dress is required for boys and girls (i.e., boys must wear shirts except at the pool, girls must wear one piece bathing suits; no short shirts or short shorts are permitted; clothing must fit appropriately, not hang below the hips).
 - No tuition will be returned for the weeks in which a student is dismissed or withdrawn.
- If your child experiences any of the following conditions, they should be kept at home until they have been symptom-free for **24 hours** or are cleared by a physician: fever greater than 100 degrees Fahrenheit, upper respiratory tract infection, vomiting, diarrhea, conjunctivitis (pink eye), streptococcal pharyngitis (strep throat), chicken pox, lice or scabies, impetigo or fungal skin infections. The Day Camp Director should be contacted if your child will be absent from camp due to illness.
- Weekly tuition payments are due by **Thursday morning** of the prior week you plan to attend; child(ren) ill not be allowed to attend camp until all due payments are made. Each camper must be signed up for **at least 4 weeks** of summer Day Camp. Please refer to the Tuition Agreement on pg. 3.
