In consideration of others: Please note that we reserve the right to evict, without refund, anyone violating these rules, destroying property, creating a disturbance or engaging in behavior not suitable in a family campground.

- Quiet hours are from 11:00pm – 8:00am
- No loud music, excessive noise, or disorderly conduct will be tolerated.
- Alcohol, illegal drugs and cigarette use is prohibited on Summit Grove grounds.
- Children (17 and under) are to be supervised by an adult at the pools, playground, restrooms, and dining hall. They must be at their campsite/room between 11:00pm and 8:00am unless escorted by an adult.

For your safety

- Remember that children are playing on the grounds at Summit Grove. Please drive at a slow and safe speed of 5 MPH.
- Campfires must be kept small and confined to grills or fire ring. Please extinguish all fires before going to bed or leaving your site.
- Fireworks, firecrackers, explosives or weapons of any kind are not permitted (including sparklers).
- When leaving your camp site/room please secure your valuable items inside your camper, vehicle or room.
- Playground hours are from 8:00am to dusk.
- Campers are responsible for the safety and discipline of their children and guest.
- Please help us keep Summit Grove safe and report any unsafe conditions or accidents immediately.

Check in and Check-out time

- Check in is 3:00pm
- Check out is 11:00am
- Sites may not be available for early arrival or late departure due to previous reservations.

Campsite

- Campsites are assigned. Please do not park or set up on any campsite or change your site to another without first checking with the office.
- PA State regulations require that sink and shower water is accumulated in a container and dumped at an approved dump station.
- Please do not walk across other occupied sites.
- Please do not move picnic tables or camp rings without approval from the office staff.
- No pets are allowed in any public building except personal areas. Please clean up after your pets!

Trash

- Collect and place in plastic bags and take to the garbage dumpsters across from the main dining hall. Do not leave trash set outside overnight, animals will get into it and make a mess.

Swimming Pool

- Open daily from Memorial Day to Labor Day, 10:00am to 10:00pm.
- Swimming pools are available for your use only during the hours posted. There may or may not be a life guard present. If no lifeguard is present you are swimming at your own risk.
- Children 14 and under are not permitted in the pool area unless accompanied by an adult 18 years or older.
- No diving or running permitted.
- Proper swimwear is required. No cut offs allowed or thong bathing suits.
- Pool will close if threatening or inclement weather is approaching or present.
- Persons using the pool must abide by the posted pool rules or they may be asked to leave the pool area.
- Please keep pets and glass containers out of the pool area.
- Swim diapers required by the little ones.

Additional Information

- Cutting down any campground trees, branches, bushes or any other foliage is not permitted.
- One camping unit and one vehicle are permitted per site, unless authorized by the office.
- Visitors are the responsibility of the camper and must also abide by these rules.
- No open fires are allowed. Fires MUST be in a fire ring or contained area.
- Fire pit is available upon request.

Pets: If your pet is staying with you during your stay here at Summit Grove please observe the following regulations.

- Pets are only allowed in the camp site facilities (tent, camper, motor home) or in personal owned cottages. Pets must be confined to these areas.
- Please clean up after your pet.
- Pets must be on a leash no longer than 6 feet at all times.
- Pets are not allowed in any public area.
- Pets must not disturb or pose a danger to other guests.
- If your pet is outside you must be outside with your pet.
- If you leave the area for the day you must ensure your pet(s) have water and food. Do not leave your pet in an un-air-conditioned environment. Pets are not to be left outside when you are not at your campsite or cottage.

Laundry

- Free use of machines if you are a camper.
- Located next to the Dining Hall.
- Available to all campers on a first come first serve basis. Be considerate of other campers and remove your clothes promptly.

Safety

- **TICKS** - Each camper and counselor shall perform a full body tick check at least once a day to check for and remove ticks. DEET may be applied to clothing to help prevent ticks from attaching.
- **POISON IVY/OAK** - Teach campers to identify it “leaflets three let them be”. If it is touched, carefully wash all exposed areas as soon as possible.
